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II.1.5) Short description of the contract or purchase(s)

The subject of this document is the supply of Poloidal Field Coils 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.

The coils are wound adjacent to the ITER site in a dedicated PF Coil fabrication building and handed over to F4E for cold testing and assembly in the ITER machine. Cold testing is considered to be the final acceptance test before handing over the coils to the ITER Organization for final assembly in the Tokamak Hall. Cold testing will be carried out under a separate F4E supply contract in another dedicated facility.

The PF magnet system is composed of six circular coils, the winding packs (WP) consisting of a stack of Double Pancakes (DP). The PF3, PF4, and PF5 coils consist of 8 DPs, whereas PF2 and PF6 consist of 6 and 9 DPs respectively.

The coils are composed of stacks of Double Pancakes (DP). Each DP is wound with two-in-hand CICC and consists of an upper and lower pancake. Each continuous section of CICC used in the two-in-hand winding is referred to as a Unit length (UL). Because of the two-in-hand winding, there are two ULs per DP.

The two-in-hand winding scheme and stacking of DPs allows for all joints to be located at the coil outer diameter, about 15 cm away from the winding pack. The winding pack current terminals are located at the outer diameter of the coil, where the CICC has its minimum bending radius of 500 mm. Given the two-in-hand winding, there is a joint between the two conductors within a DP (internal joint or PJ joints), as well as joints between adjacent DPs (external joints or DPJ). Having all joints on the outer diameter allows for the ability to bypass a double pancake in the event of a short by opening three joints and reconnecting two of them.

The ULs are delivered to the Coil Supplier for coil winding and fabrication. After reception at the PF Coil Fabrication Building, the Conductor ULs are bent to the coil radius, insulated, and wound into the final coil dimensions using appropriate tooling. The DPs are impregnated, stacked together and the outer joints are completed. The stack is then wrapped in a layer of ground insulation and impregnated in a mould to complete the WP. After completion of the winding pack all support clamps, cover plates, jumpers, cooling pipes and instrumentation systems will be installed and the coil prepared for cold testing.

The execution of the contract is divided in the following stages:

- * Stage 1 (firm) - Manufacturing Preparation and Qualification.
- * Stage 2 (option) - Fabrication of PF5 and PF6.
- * Stage 3 (option) - Fabrication of PF2, PF3 and PF4.

III.2) CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

III.2.1) Personal situation of economic operators, including requirements relating to enrolment on professional or trade registers

Information and formalities necessary for evaluating if requirements are met:

This procurement procedure shall be open on equal terms to tenderers that are nationals of a Member of Fusion for Energy or are established in the territory of a Member of Fusion for Energy (i.e. Member States of the European Union and Switzerland).

Tenderers shall be excluded from participation in the present procurement procedure if:

a) they are bankrupt or being wound up, are having their affairs administered by the courts, have entered into an arrangement with creditors, have suspended business activities, are the subject of proceedings concerning those matters, or are in any analogous situation arising from a similar procedure provided for in national legislation or regulations;

b) they have been convicted of an offence concerning their professional conduct by a judgement which has the force of res judicata;

c) they have been guilty of grave professional misconduct proven by any means which the Joint Undertaking can justify;

d) they have not fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of social security contributions or the payment of taxes in accordance with the legal provisions of the country in which they are established or with those of the country of the Joint Undertaking or those of the country where the contract is to be performed;

e) they have been the subject of a judgement which has the force of res judicata for fraud, corruption, involvement in a criminal organisation or any other illegal activity detrimental to the Joint Undertaking's or the Communities financial interests;

f) they are currently subject to an administrative penalty imposed by the Community institutions as referred to in the Financial Regulation applicable to the budget of the European communities.

Tenderers shall be excluded from the award of the contract if during the present procurement procedure:

g) they are subject to a conflict of interest

h) they are guilty of misrepresentation in supplying the information required by the Joint Undertaking as a condition of participation in the contract procedure or fail to supply this information.

NB: In their tenders, tenderers shall provide a declaration on their honour, duly signed and dated, stating that they are not in one of the situations listed above, based on the Specimen in Annex 3. Only the tenderer to whom the contract is to be awarded shall provide the documents mentioned below before signature of the contract and within the deadline given by Fusion for Energy.

The following documents will be accepted as proof that the tenderer is not in any of the situations mentioned in points a), b), c), d), e), f):

i) for a), b) and e), the production of a recent extract from the judicial record or, failing that, an equivalent document recently issued by a judicial or administrative authority in the country of origin or provenance, showing that those requirements are satisfied;

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ii) in the case mentioned in d), a recent certificate issued by the competent authority of the Member State concerned.

Where the document or certificate referred to above is not issued in the country concerned it may be replaced by a sworn or, failing that, a solemn statement made by the interested party before a judicial or administrative authority, a notary or a qualified professional body in its country of origin or provenance;

iii) in the cases mentioned in c) and f), the tenderer will have to provide a sworn or, failing that, a solemn statement made by the interested party before a judicial or administrative authority, a notary or a qualified professional body in its country of origin or provenance.

Depending on the national legislation of the country in which the tenderer is established, the documents referred to above shall relate to legal persons and/or natural persons including company directors or any person with powers of representation, decision-making or control in relation to the tenderer.

Fusion for Energy may waive the obligation of the winning tenderer to submit this evidence if it has already been submitted to Fusion for Energy for the purposes of another procurement procedure and provided that the documents are not more than one year old starting from their issuing date and that they are still valid.

In case of joint tenders (consortiums) the exclusion criteria will be assessed individually to each member of the consortium. Therefore, the declaration on honour (template in Annex 3), duly signed and dated, stating that the tenderer is not in one of the situations listed in Section 9, must be provided by each of the members of the group. If a member of the consortium is subject to exclusion, the rest of the consortium shall be excluded.

In addition, the following information and documents shall be provided in the tender:

a) Full name of the entity, legal status, registration number, VAT number, address, telephone and fax numbers, the name of the contact person responsible for the tender as well as the name of the legal representative of the entity, as signatory of the contract (Annex 5 – Identification form).

b) Commercial undertakings must provide a transcript or a certificate, issued by the competent body (namely the commercial register in the country of provenance or the country of the main office of the candidate) or their act of incorporation as commercial undertakings.

Non-commercial undertakings may provide a copy of their act of incorporation if, under the law of their country of provenance or the country of their main office, they are not subject to public registry.

Non-commercial physical persons must provide a copy of their passport or other equivalent identification document.

c) Power of attorney duly completed and signed to demonstrate that the person signing is entitled to take commitment on behalf of the Company.

- The evaluation will be considered negative if ratio < 0.4.

• Solvency:

- Ratio: $\text{Total debt} / (\text{Capital and reserves} - 50\% \text{ of intangible fixed assets})$

- The evaluation will be considered negative if ratio > 7 or < 0.

• Profitability.

- Ratio: $\text{Gross Operating Profit} / \text{Turnover}$

- The evaluation will be considered negative if ratio < 0.05

With regard to joint tenders (groupings) the minimum viability standards will be assessed individually in relation to each member of the grouping. If a grouping member fails to meet the selection criteria, the whole grouping shall be rejected.

b) Noteworthy values to be achieved.

• Turnover.

- Noteworthy value: Average overall turnover.

- Evaluation: Negative if noteworthy value < 30,000,000 €.

• Cashflow:

With regard to joint tenders (groupings) the noteworthy values will be assessed globally (all members of the grouping together).

In relation with both a) and b):

(i) The economic and financial capacity will be considered adequate for performance of the contract if at least two of the three minimum viability standards (liquidity, solvency, profitability) are considered positively and at least one of the two noteworthy values/ratios (turnover, cashflow) are considered positively.

(ii) If, for some exceptional reason which Fusion for Energy considers justified, the tenderer is unable to provide the references requested above, its economic and financial capacity may be proved by any other means which the Joint Undertaking considers appropriate.

(iii) An economic operator may, where appropriate, rely on the capacities of other entities including subcontractors, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. It must in that case prove to the Joint Undertaking that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an Undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Templates for this purpose are provided in Annex 12 and 13 of the Tender Specifications.

III.2.3) Technical capacity

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Information and formalities necessary for evaluating if requirements are met:

The tenderer must have adequate technical and professional capacity to perform the contract within the indicated timeframe. The tenderer shall meet the below requirements and provide the following documents:

a) Experience, in the last ten years, in each of the technical competences below:

(i) Winding and vacuum-pressure impregnation of large coils. For the purpose of this call for tender "large coils" are understood to be coils:

- Having at least 2 of the 3 dimensions larger than 1/4 of the equivalent dimensions of the PF6 coil; and
- Wound using a conductor with a cross section larger than 1/5 of the PF coil conductor.

(ii) Welding of stainless steel vacuum components.

(iii) Utilization of all the following quality control techniques:

- Precise dimensional check (1 tenth of a mm) of components of at least 10 m.
- NDT tests for welds
- Leak testing at levels of 10⁻⁸ mbar l /sec
- High voltage electrical insulation testing (> 5KV).

As evidence of the experience under a), the tenderer shall submit:

- A statement duly signed by the legal representative; and
- A list of at least 1 project with regard to point (i) above and 2 projects with regard to points (ii) and (iii) above, which are relevant to the mentioned capabilities. The tender shall provide a brief description of the activities, the processes and technologies carried out, point of contact (name + tel. number), name of the customer, year and duration of the contract performance and budget per projects; and
- Any other piece of evidence capable of supporting the provided information (e.g. company brochures, clients' declarations).

b) Experience, in the last ten years, in each of the managerial competences below:

(i) Large projects (contract value > 10 M Euros);

(ii) Quality assurance certificate ISO 9001 (or equivalent);

(iii) Management of fabrication facilities with the following characteristics:

- more than one production line for the fabrication of magnet components (or similar electrical or mechanical devices); and
- management of teams of engineers/workers composed of at least 10 people in two shifts; and
- to work in clean conditions according to ISO class 9 or better.

As evidence of the experience under point b), the tenderer shall submit:

- A statement duly signed by its legal representative; and
- A list of at least 5 projects with regard to points (i) (ii) above and 2 projects with regard to point (iii), which are relevant to the mentioned capabilities. The tender shall

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provide a brief description of the activities carried out, the management strategy, description of the production lines implemented, description of the quality assurance strategy implemented, point of contact (name + tel. number), name of the customer, year and duration of the contract performance and budget per projects; and
- Any other piece of evidence capable of supporting the provided information (e.g. company brochures, clients' declarations).

c) The organisational chart in terms of manpower proposed for the execution of the contract and their detailed educational and professional qualification.

The organisational chart in terms of manpower proposed for the execution of the contract shall contain as a minimum:

(i) The Project Manager (both for the whole contract and for each partner in case of grouping of economic operators).

(ii) The responsible for engineering.

(iii) The responsible for manufacturing.

(iv) The responsible for tooling.

(v) The responsible for quality assurance.

(vi) The responsible for safety.

Each of the people above shall have at least 10 years of professional experience and a minimum of 3 years in the specific role assigned. In addition the same person cannot be designated for two or more of these roles.

As evidence of the capabilities under point c), the tenderer shall submit:

- The organisational chart for this project, and
- Detailed education, professional training and professional background of the profiles above.

d) Reliability of the needed resources for the execution of the contract.

The candidate shall prove that appropriate capacities (technical and manpower resources) will be timely available for the implementation of the Contract.

As evidence of the capabilities under point d) the tenderer shall submit:

- A statement duly signed by its legal representative committing to timely devote enough technical, financial and manpower resources for the execution of the contract; and

- Any other piece of evidence capable of supporting the provided information.

In case of joint tenders (groupings) the technical and professional capacity will be assessed in relation to the combined capacities of all members of the grouping, as a whole.

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other entities including subcontractors shall be without prejudice to the question of the tenderers liability. As the supply of the PF Coils is considered to be complex, the evidence of technical and professional capacity may be secured by means of a check carried out by the Joint Undertaking, or, on its behalf, by a third party duly authorised or by a competent official body of the country in which the supplier is established, subject to that body's agreement. Such checks shall concern the supplier's technical capacity and production capacity and, if necessary, its study and research facilities and quality control measures.
